When someone says “shalom,” they are saying “I wish you peace and wellness in every area of your life... spirit, soul, and body.” The prophet, Isaiah used “Shalom shalom” as a compound word, and rendered it “perfect peace.” This compound use of “peace peace” gives emphasis to the statement and increases the status of the word. Perfect peace suggest that there is perfect harmony, perfect balance perfect wholeness, and perfect completeness. God wants each of us to live in a state of perfect peace. He wants us to live in abundance and total human flourishing. The Bible promises us that we can have peace with God, as well as the peace of God through Jesus Christ our Lord!

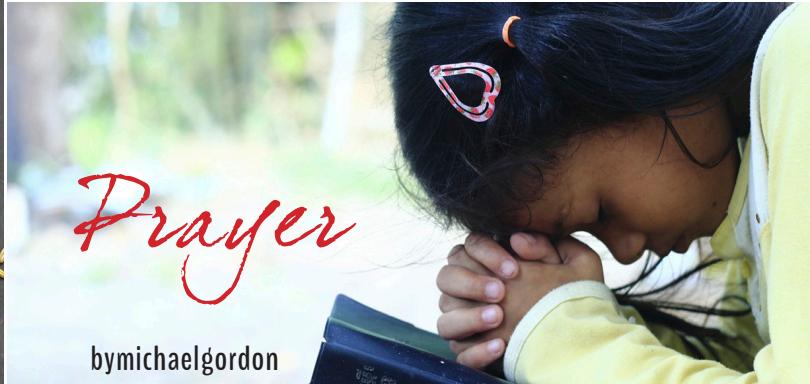

FENNEL TEA

INGREDIENTS

**1 ounce or 2 tablespoon of Fennel Seed
(crushed or powdered)**

1 1/4 pints or 2.5 cups of Distilled water

Boil the water, and while boiling pour over the seeds. Cover and steep in a hot place for 30 minutes. Strain and add 4 ounces honey. Cool, bottle and store in a cold place.

DOSE: One 12-16 oz glass with or after each meal.

Children: One tablespoon 3 or 4 times a day. For colds (children) one 12-16 oz glass in hot water before going to bed.

Adults: Take one 6oz cup, hot, every hour, and keep body warm.
